Their leadership exemplifies some of the best practices for the creativity, spiritual depth, and moral leadership that is possible when we embrace the work of shared ministry rooted in love and justice.



The budget is based on the assumption that the church will reopen for in-person services and other in-person programs in early September. In addition, we intend to stream our worship services from the church after we return.
