Among the items you can bid on are three important "Fund-A-Need" opportunities to help offset expenses that support our safe re-opening for worship and other activities. Please consider lending your support to the initiatives outlined below. You'll find them on *BidBeacon*; click on Cash Donations, for complete descriptions and to place your bid.

- 15 donations of \$40 for "Improved Ventilation" will help offset the cost of our new system-wide ionization units which make our furnace filters more effective against pathogens plus other clean air measures still being evaluated.
- 15 donations of \$45 to keep the Piano well-maintained and in-tune. It is soon due for a major "re-voicing and regulation", a considerable expense.
- 15 donations of \$50 will help implement a "Multiplatform Technology" capability for live-streaming services and other group activities so all can virtually attend and participate even if capacity is still limited, or they cannot be physically present.

Neil Porter will once again be our Raffle Master drawing the names of winners while you watch. 


