

#### REOPENING PLANS SIMPLIFIED

TUUC intends to re-open for in-person worship when the COVID ActNow website shows Baltimore County, MD at the risk level Medium for 14 consecutive days, and when we have the capability to stream our worship services from the meeting room.

#### **EARL'S PLACE**

Earl's Place, along with Prospect Place, are programs of Cornerstone Community Housing (CCH). CCH is dedicated to helping men experiencing homelessness rebuild their lives and to changing attitudes toward homelessness through outreach and education. Earl's Place, which is a stepping stone on the way to attaining a permanent home, houses 17 men at a time. The support of organizations like TUUC help provide the steady income necessary to provide hope, help and home to men experiencing homelessness.
