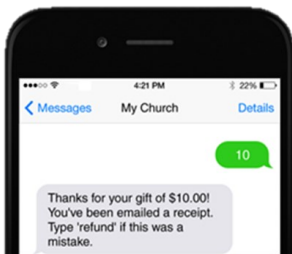

OUR MESSY LIVES TO BE HELD ON ZOOM ON THURSDAY, APRIL 21

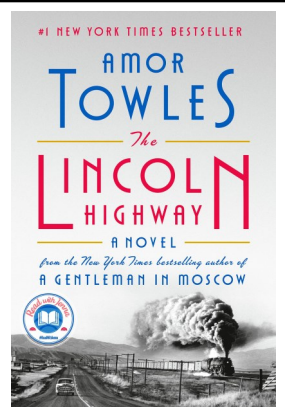
