Today marks the 50th anniversary of the passage of Roe V. Wade. This decision affirmed that the government should not intrude on private family decisions or on the decisions made between a woman and her doctor. But the Supreme Court struck down this ruling in June leaving it to states to legislate the reproductive rights of women and families. Where do we go from here to fulfill a vision of reproductive justice that affirms the right to have a child, the right to not have a child, and the right to raise children in safe and healthy environments?

Today we will recognize our newest TUUC members and Patty Barry, Chair of the Membership Committee, will share how serving on this team has helped her to find her center.


